

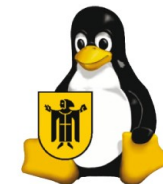

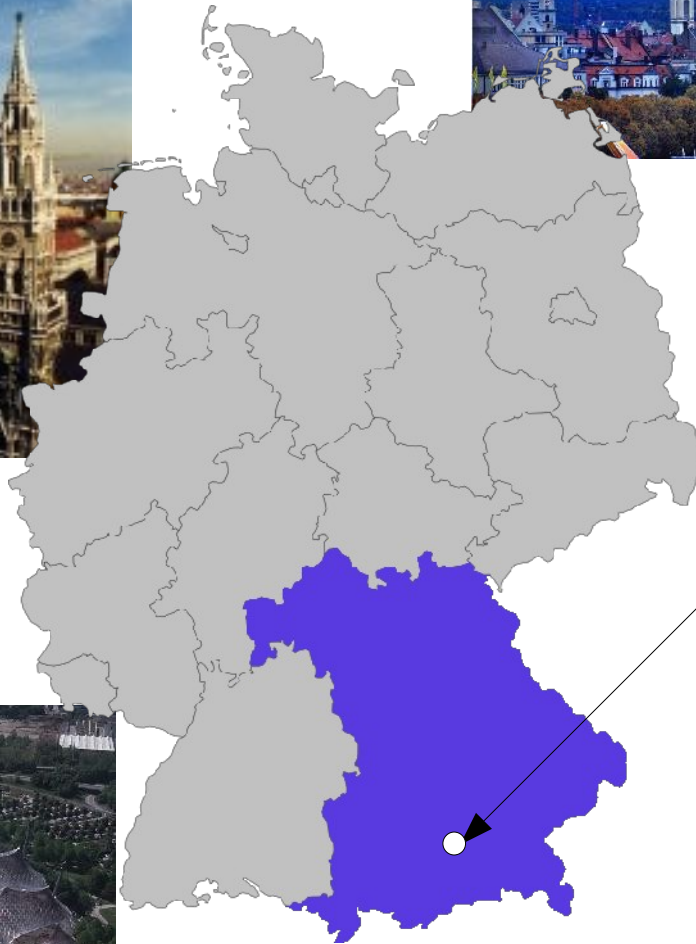

# This is LiMux

## Objectives

- More independence from software suppliers
- More equality of opportunities => more competition in the software market
- Controlling of costs (reduction)
- Complete open source code (maintenance, security)
- Demands on the protection of personal data

## Decisions

- Free software for the operating system and office software
- Platform independent business applications

## Up to date numbers

**14,000 workstations use free software**

- E-Mail and browser everywhere

**8,500 employees trained to use free software**

- In training courses and additionally via elearning

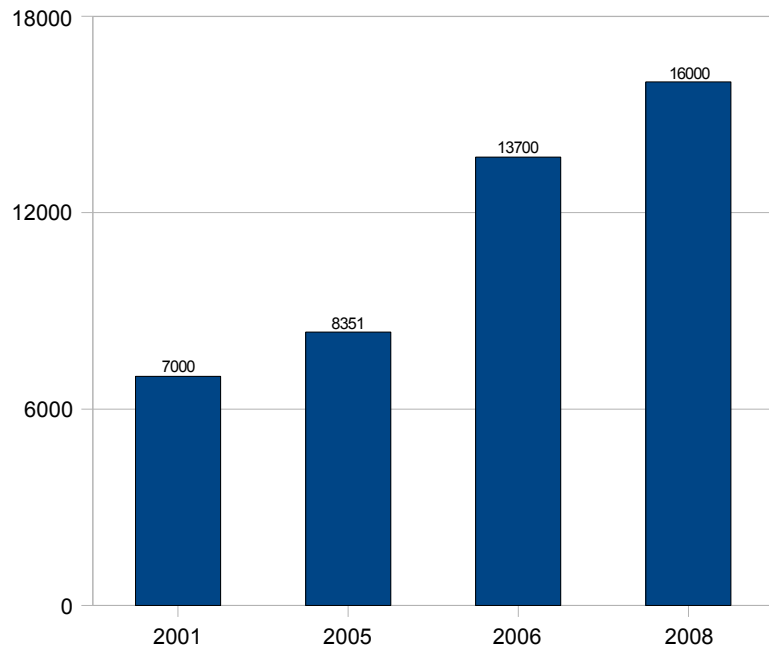
**8,000 workstations use OpenOffice.org**

- ODF is going to be the standard interchange format

**1,200 workstations run with the linux client**

- 2 out of 12 department nearly completely migrated

# Demands on the migration



## Main results of detailed conception study (macros, templates, forms)

- ~ 16,000 MTF objects to be migrated
- Software solution redundancies, different solutions for same problems
- File exchange between Microsoft Office and OpenOffice.org

## Migration is an opportunity for

- Consolidation: One solution for equal requirements
- Standardization: Same technical base

## WollMux as office solution

is the title of an office solution including the following components

### Letter head system (reducing the migration of macros for 20%)

- automatical fill in of user data by login
- writing as another person (e.g. secretariat)

### Form system

- compiling and adapting of templates or forms
- generating documents based on this forms

### Text module system:

- Helps by assembling documents with text modules / paper based workflows
- generating and printing of different document versions with special official degrees

## WollMux as office solution

### Facts:

- OpenOffice.org extension
- written in Java
- JRE from 1.5, OpenOffice.org from 2.04
- development since 2005
- until today more than 8,000 workstations in Munich use it

## Reasons for WollMux becoming free software

### „Demand“ from the market

- Many solutions for Microsoft Office, only a few for OpenOffice.org
- Similar challenges at every public authority which uses OpenOffice.org
- Direct demand from others who visited us

### WollMux is free software

- published under the European Union Public License (EUPL)

# Advantages of releasing WollMux as free software

## For other municipalities

- Benefit from our experiences

## For the Municipality of Munich

- We benefit from your enhancements, experiences and patches
- Bugs in OpenOffice.org, which get visible by using the WollMux, could be better reproduced and solved

## For OpenOffice.org

- WollMux heavily stresses OpenOffice.org and the UNO-API – you can use WollMux as stress test during quality assurance

## Digression: Reasons for choosing the EUPL as license

### Choosing the EUPL as free software license

(from <http://ec.europa.eu/idabc/en/document/7584#faq11>)

- Officially developed and approved Open Source licence by the EU
- Available in all (except the Irish) official languages of the European Union and may produce legal effects in any of these languages
- Considers the specificity and diversity of Member States Law and the Community Law (copyright terminology, information, warranty, liability, applicable law and jurisdiction)
- Ensures downstream compatibility issues with the most relevant other licences (including the most intensively used, the General Public licence or GPL)
