

What specific conditions exist?

Lunchtime catering provisions

Your child will continue to be able to enjoy the lunchtime catering provisions in school or nursery (parent/guardian contribution €1.00). However, you are required to apply for the cost cover during the period approved for your social benefits by the social welfare office.

Trips

You will need to apply to your social welfare office for the costs of daytrips from school or nursery. It is best to do so on a flat-rate basis for the period approved for your social benefits. You will need to submit a separate application for trips lasting multiple days.

School supplies

Those entitled to benefits in accordance with SGB II, SGB XII and AsylbLG will continue to receive a payment for school supplies - of €100.00 - without submitting an application. From the 2011/2012 school year, this will be paid out as two part-payments of €70.00 for the first half school year and €30.00 for the second half school year. Individuals entitled to housing and child benefit must apply for these payments.

Activities payments (sport, music, culture, etc)

We recommend that you apply for these payments immediately, even if you are unable to specify a definitive requirement at present. In this way you can "save up" contribution payments of €10.00 per month during the period approved for your social benefits. Please note that the confirmation from the establishment, the association or the music school must always bear the account details of the same.

Learning support

If your child is experiencing difficulties attaining the class targets then it is possible to apply for learning support. The approval requires confirmation from the school. The maximum hourly subsidies available are €20.00 for individual lessons and €10.00 for group lessons. This allows you to choose where your child obtains his or her out-of-class support.

School transport subsidy

In Bavaria, costs are usually covered by the law governing free travel to and from school.

The education package:
Making participation possible

“Making participation possible”

The education package provides 31,000 children in Munich with enhanced prospects for the future. It is a particular intention of the City of Munich and the Jobcenter to ensure that all children and young people profit from these benefits. The education package follows the guiding principle: Making participation possible – providing children with opportunities. You will find the most important information on the new benefits here.



Who is eligible for these benefits?

All children, adolescents and young adults below the age of 25 who receive benefits in accordance with social code II (SGB II), social code XII (SGB XII) or the law governing asylum welfare entitlements (AsylbLG), and those whose parents receive housing or child benefits.

What benefits are available?

- Lunchtime catering provisions in school or nursery
- Single and multi-day trips
- Learning support – out-of-school teaching
- Sport, music and cultural activities – €10.00 per month up to the age of 18
- Funding for school supplies – €100.00 per school year
- School transport funding

How do I receive these benefits?

Benefits are only available on application. This applies in particular to the lunchtime catering provisions in the school and nursery.

In future, you will need to **reapply** for education and activities benefits with every new approval of ongoing benefits submitted in accordance with SGB II, SGB XII or AsylbLG. The same applies if your housing benefit or child benefit approval expires.

Where can you apply for these benefits?

You can apply for the benefits from your social welfare office. You can find the application form – as well as information on the actual offerings within your district – on the internet.

How are the benefits paid out?

We always make payments directly to the service provider (school, association, music school, etc). It is not possible to transfer the payments to your account. One exception to this is the funding for school supplies, which is transferred to your account in part-payments in August (€70.00) and February (€30.00).
